A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO HELP PROVIDE EQUAL ACCESS AND
2 QUALITY HUMAN SERVICES DELIVERY FOR THE DEAF AND HARD OF
3 HEARING.

5 Whereas, the 600,000 deaf and hard of hearing citizens of North Carolina do
6 not have equal access to any area of human service delivery; and

7 Whereas, the Division of Services for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing and its
8 six Regional Resource Centers have never been staffed to serve the needs of the deaf
9 and hard of hearing; and

10 Whereas, the 1992 Task Force on Quality Assurance for the Deaf and Hard of
11 Hearing provided the Division of Services for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing with a
12 comprehensive cradle to grave plan for the deaf and hard of hearing which addresses the
13 needs of both constituency groups; and

14 Whereas, the Americans with Disabilities Act requires the provision of equal
15 access for deaf and hard of hearing individuals through qualified interpreters and/or
16 assistive listening devices/systems; Now, therefore,
17 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

18 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of
19 Services for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing, Department of Human Resources, the sum
20 of one million seventeen thousand seventy-nine dollars (\$1,017,079) for the 1993-94
21 fiscal year and the sum of one million two hundred sixty-nine thousand seven hundred
22 seventy-five dollars (\$1,269,775) for the 1994-95 fiscal year, for the Regional Resource

- 1 Centers for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing, to help provide equal access and quality
- 2 human services delivery for the deaf and hard of hearing.
- 3 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
