2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO CONDUCT A STUDY OF CHILDHOOD HUNGER IN NORTH CAROLINA. 3 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of 5 Governors of The University of North Carolina for the University of North Carolina at 6 Chapel Hill, School of Public Health, the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 7 1993-94 fiscal year to conduct a study of childhood hunger in North Carolina. The 9 study shall: 10 Examine the extent of hunger among children in the State and its (1) 11

- Examine the availability and use of publicly funded feeding programs; (2)
- Examine the association between hunger and child health. (3)
- The School of Public Health shall report its findings to the General Assembly on or 15 before March 1, 1994. 16
