A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO MODIFY THE PURPOSES FOR WHICH LUMBERTON MAY USE
ITS OCCUPANCY TAX PROCEEDS.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Chapter 935 of the 1987 Session Laws is repealed.

Sec. 2. Section 3.2 of Chapter 1028 of the 1983 Session Laws is rewritten to
read:

"Sec. 3.2. Section 40 of Chapter 908 of the 1983 Session Laws is amended by
adding the following at the end: 'In the City of Lumberton, these funds may be used for
any lawful purpose.'"

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification, and applies to taxes that accrue
on or after the date of ratification.
