A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION  
SHALL PAY FOR THE NONBETTERMENT RELOCATION OF SANITARY  
DISTRICT UTILITIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 136-27.1 reads as rewritten:

**"§ 136-27.1. Relocation of water and sewer lines of municipalities and nonprofit  
water or sewer corporations or associations.**

The Department of Transportation shall pay the nonbetterment cost for the  
relocation of water and sewer lines, located within the existing State highway right-of-  
way, that are necessary to be relocated for a State highway improvement project and  
that are owned by: (i) a municipality with a population of 5,500 or less according  
to the latest decennial census; (ii) a nonprofit water or sewer association or corporation;  
~~or~~ (iii) any water or sewer system organized pursuant to Chapter 162A of the General  
~~Statutes~~ Statutes; or (iv) any sanitary district organized pursuant to Part 2 of Article 2  
of Chapter 130A of the General Statutes."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
