A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR A TEN PERCENT INCREASE IN PAYMENTS UNDER THE MEDICAID AND AID TO FAMILIES WITH DEPENDENT CHILDREN PROGRAMS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Effective October 1, 1993, the maximum net family annual income eligibility standards for Medicaid and Aid to Families with Dependent Children, and the Standard of Need for Aid to Families with Dependent Children shall be as follows:

1 \*Aid to Families with Dependent Children (AFDC); Aid to the Aged (AA); Aid to the  
2 Blind (AB); and Aid to the Disabled (AD).

3 The payment level for Aid to Families with Dependent Children shall be fifty percent  
4 (50%) of the standard of need.

5         These standards may be changed with the approval of the Director of the  
6 Budget with the advice of the Advisory Budget Commission.

7         Sec. 2. (a) There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of  
8 Social Services, Department of Human Resources, the sum of five million four hundred  
9 ninety-nine thousand eight hundred fifty-six dollars (\$5,499,856) and the sum of eight  
10 million six hundred ninety-eight thousand one hundred fourteen dollars (\$8,698,114) for  
11 the 1994-95 fiscal year to implement this act.

12         (b) There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of Medical  
13 Assistance, Department of Human Resources, the sum of fourteen million one hundred  
14 forty-four thousand one hundred forty-four dollars (\$14,144,144) for the 1993-94 fiscal  
15 year and the sum of eighteen million nine hundred forty-eight thousand four hundred  
16 ninety dollars (\$18,948,490) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to implement this act.

17         Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
