- 1 *Aid to Families with Dependent Children (AFDC); Aid to the Aged (AA); Aid to the 2 Blind (AB); and Aid to the Disabled (AD).
 - The payment level for Aid to Families with Dependent Children shall be fifty percent (50%) of the standard of need.

These standards may be changed with the approval of the Director of the Budget with the advice of the Advisory Budget Commission.

- Sec. 2. (a) There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of Social Services, Department of Human Resources, the sum of five million four hundred ninety-nine thousand eight hundred fifty-six dollars (\$5,499,856) and the sum of eight million six hundred ninety-eight thousand one hundred fourteen dollars (\$8,698,114) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to implement this act.
- (b) There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of Medical Assistance, Department of Human Resources, the sum of fourteen million one hundred forty-four thousand one hundred forty-four dollars (\$14,144,144) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of eighteen million nine hundred forty-eight thousand four hundred ninety dollars (\$18,948,490) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to implement this act.
 - Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
