**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CULTURAL  
RESOURCES FOR THE MUSEUM OF THE ALBEMARLE IN ELIZABETH  
CITY.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Cultural Resources the sum of eight million eight hundred twenty thousand eighty-four dollars (\$8,820,084) for the 1993-94 fiscal year to purchase land for and construct a new building for the Museum of the Albemarle, which is a branch of the North Carolina Museum of History located in Elizabeth City.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
