Whereas, protecting the health and safety of North Carolina's workers is a primary responsibility of the Department of Labor; and

Whereas, the safety consultants and inspectors who teach and consult with workers about workplace health and safety require additional support and personnel to best assist employers across North Carolina; and

Whereas, the administrative services offered by the Department of Labor provide information, education, and training, as well as the expertise to help to decrease workplace illnesses and injuries and to provide the first line of communications and assistance to the State's employers and employees; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Labor the sum of three million eight thousand one hundred seventy-three dollars (3,008,173) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for additional staff and equipment needs.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
