1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE NORTH CAROLINA ACADEMY
3	OF PERFORMING ARTS.
4	Whereas, the film industry in North Carolina brought over a half billion
5	dollars to North Carolina's economy last year alone; and
6	Whereas, North Carolina was ranked the number two state in the nation by
7	the Association of Film Commissioners International; and
8	Whereas, Wilmington was the focus of film production in the State last year,
9	hosting 18 feature films, 24 television episodes, and 19 other projects totalling
10	approximately \$391,000,000; and
11	Whereas, the film industry is economically viable in the Wilmington area, but
12	the missing link to greater production in the area is education and the training of actors,
13	directors, and producers who originate these types of projects in North Carolina; Now,
14	therefore,
15	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
16	Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Dennis Hopper
17	Academy of Performing Arts, Inc., the sum of two million five hundred thousand
18	dollars (\$2,500,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for capital improvements to the North
19	Carolina Academy of Performing Arts to be allocated as follows:
20	(1) \$2,000,000 to upgrade the facility's theater space and rehearsal halls;
21	and
22	$(2) \qquad \$500,000 \text{ for start-up costs.}$
23	Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
