A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ONSLOW COUNTY TO CONDUCT A  
FEASIBILITY STUDY ON AN AGRICULTURE MULTIPURPOSE FACILITY.

Whereas, the Onslow County Board of Commissioners is committed to  
improving and expanding Onslow County's economy through diversification; and

Whereas, the Board of Commissioners' steering committee has been working  
diligently in researching, evaluating, surveying, and discussing potential benefits to  
Onslow County of an agriculture multipurpose facility; and

Whereas, preliminary information indicates that an agriculture multipurpose  
facility with arenas, livestock areas, and related amenities may significantly increase  
agriculture and entertainment activities and events in the County; and

Whereas, the Board of Commissioners concludes and believes that an  
agriculture multipurpose facility would economically and culturally benefit the County  
and the region; and

Whereas, more substantive information needs to be developed in order to  
detail and document the agricultural, cultural, and economic benefits and advantages of  
an agriculture multipurpose facility; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Onslow County  
the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to hire a  
professional staff to conduct a feasibility study on the agriculture and economic benefits  
to Onslow County of an agriculture multipurpose facility.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
