A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ESTABLISH THE INSTITUTE OF
TECHNOLOGY TRAINING IN THE OFFICE OF THE STATE CONTROLLER.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Office of the State Controller the sum of one hundred eighty-nine thousand dollars (\$189,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to establish and operate the Institute of Technology Training, which will serve State and local governments and the general public as a central point of contact for planning, arranging, and coordinating the broad diversity of seminars and classes involved in the education, training, and professional development necessary to implement and use essential elements of modern information technology and telecommunications. The Institute will report to the Information Resource Management Commission, which is the policy-setting body for the executive branch of State government.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
