A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO INCREASE FUNDING FOR IN-HOME
AIDE SERVICES AND CAREGIVER SUPPORT SERVICES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Human Resources the sum of seven million five hundred six thousand three hundred thirty-eight dollars (\$7,506,338) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of eight million five hundred thirty-five thousand seventy-two dollars (\$8,535,072) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to fund in-home aide services and caregiver support services.

Sec. 2. These funds shall be used only for direct services.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
