3	PERFORMANCE AUDIT COMMITTEE TO INITIATE SYSTEMATIC, IN-
4	DEPTH EVALUATIONS OF PROGRAM RESULTS.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. G.S. 120-76(1) reads as rewritten:
7	"(1) To conduct program evaluation studies of the various components of
8	State agency activity as they relate to:
9	a. Service benefits of each program relative to expenditures;
10	b. Achievement of program goals;
11	c. Use of indicators by which the success or failure of a program
12	may be gauged; and
13	d. Conformity with legislative intent.
14	The Commission shall develop a schedule for systematic program
15	evaluation studies of State agencies. In setting its priorities for
16	program review and evaluation, the Commission shall consider reports
17	from the Director of the Budget on programs that have not achieved
18	the desired level of performance.
19	The Commission shall develop strategies for carrying out these
20	program evaluation studies, after consultation with the State Auditor.
21	The Director of the Budget shall ensure that the results of these
22	program evaluations are used by State agencies in the State's policy,
23	planning, and budgeting processes.

1	The chairs of the Commission shall appoint a permanent
2	subcommittee to assist the Commission in carrying out its duties under
3	this subdivision."
