EFFECTIVE DATE: This act is effective upon ratification, This act shall expire on July 1, 1995, and shall not apply with respect to primaries or elections held on or after July 1, 1995.

ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY: The assumption is that this act does not add to or subtract from the responsibilities of the State Board of Elections. One impact this bill may have would be requiring local boards of elections to hire temporary help due to the shorten time frame of moving the primary from May to nine weeks prior to the general election. This bill will shorten the time between the primary and the general election by about four months. The costs, if any, for temporary help would be negligible.
