BILL SUMMARY S 101. **SCHOOL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS.** "TO AUTHORIZE LOCAL BOARDS OF EDUCATION TO WAIVE THE AGE REQUIREMENTS FOR ENROLLMENT IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS." Amends GS 115C-364 (requiring child be 5 years old to enter public kindergarten) to allow local boards to waive the age requirement if child's birthday falls on or before Oct. 16 of year child is to enroll and child is sufficiently mature to be appropriately served in the public schools.
