ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY:

- 1. Assume that only the Teach for America program recruits would use this to take courses at in-state rates. Other lateral entry teachers from out-of-state would be eligible, but Fiscal Research has been unable to obtain any estimates of the number affected. Therefore, these cost estimates should be seen as a lower bound.
- 2. Assume 30 recruits for Teacher for America for fall, 1993. Estimate that 50% will take one course each semester, and that 75% will take two courses in summer school. We assume that these will all be new students (i.e., none are taking courses now because of high non-resident tuition rates).
- 3. Because most of these provisionally certified teachers are in the northeastern part of the State, tuition rates for East Carolina and Elizabeth City State are used in making estimates.

- 4. The additional costs are from additional funding for full-time equivalent students and for resident summer school credit hours.
- 5. No projections for growth in the program or for inflation are included.
