February 15, 1994 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE EDUCATION OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE TO STUDY PROVIDING A TUITION INCENTIVE FOR NORTH CAROLINA STUDENTS ENROLLED IN IN-STATE AND OUT-OF-STATE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION AND PROPRIETARY SCHOOLS IN ORDER TO EFFECT LONG-TERM CRIME PREVENTION BY AIDING PEOPLE TO BE PROPERLY TRAINED AND GAINFULLY EMPLOYED. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: The Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee is Section 1. authorized to study whether the State should provide tuition incentives for North Carolina students enrolled in in-State and out-of-State institutions of higher education and proprietary schools to effect long-term crime prevention by aiding people to be properly trained and gainfully employed. The Committee shall determine whether such tuition incentives are feasible and the amount of funding that would be required to provide such incentives. The Committee shall report its findings and recommendations to the 1995
