13	of 1993, are reduced by one percent (1%).

21	are head of;			
22	(4) By the Executive Secretary-Director of the State Board of Elections to			
23	the State Board of Elections;			
24	(5) By the Legislative Services Commission to the General Assembly;

3	(7)	By the State Board of Community Colleges to the Department of	
4		Community Colleges and all community colleges;	
5	(8)	By the Administrative Officer of the Courts to the Judicial
