A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REDUCE GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATIONS BY ONE PERCENT  
OTHER THAN TO THE DEPARTMENTS OF JUSTICE, CORRECTION, AND  
CRIME CONTROL AND PUBLIC SAFETY.

Whereas, controlling and preventing crime will require substantial additional  
funds, which are not currently available after meeting other needs; and

Whereas, across-the-board cuts can provide the money; Now, therefore,  
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Except for appropriations made by that section to the Department  
of Justice, the Department of Correction, or to the Department of Crime Control and  
Public Safety, all General Fund appropriations for fiscal year 1993-94 made by Section  
3 of Chapter 321 of the 1993 Session Laws, the Current Operations Appropriations Act  
of 1993, are reduced by one percent (1%).

Sec. 2. The reductions taken by Section 1 of this act shall be applied as  
follows:

- (1) By the Governor to the Office of the Governor and to the departments  
established by Chapter 143B of the General Statutes and to any  
reserves not yet allocated;
- (2) By the Lieutenant Governor to the Office of the Lieutenant Governor;
- (3) By each other member of the Council of State to the Department they  
are head of;
- (4) By the Executive Secretary-Director of the State Board of Elections to  
the State Board of Elections;
- (5) By the Legislative Services Commission to the General Assembly;

- 1           (6) By the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina to The  
2           University of North Carolina System;
- 3           (7) By the State Board of Community Colleges to the Department of  
4           Community Colleges and all community colleges;
- 5           (8) By the Administrative Officer of the Courts to the Judicial  
6           Department;
- 7           (9) By the State Board of Education to the Department of Public  
8           Instruction, State Aid to Local School Administrative Units, and the  
9           State Board of Education;
- 10          (10) By the State Controller for the Office of the State Controller;
- 11          (11) By the Rules Review Commission for the Rules Review Commission;  
12          and
- 13          (12) By the Director of the Office of Administrative Hearings for the Office  
14          of Administrative Hearings.
- 15          Sec. 3. This act does not apply to Local Government Shared Revenue and to  
16          Debt Service.
- 17          Sec. 4. Funds made available by Section 1 of this act may be appropriated by  
18          the General Assembly for controlling and preventing crime.
- 19          Sec. 5. This act is effective upon ratification.
