A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE TRIANGLE NATIVE AMERICAN SOCIETY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Triangle Native American Society, Inc., the sum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) for the 1995-96 fiscal year to assist in its mission to educate the general public and promote and protect the traditions and culture of Native Americans. These funds will be used to secure art and traveling exhibits, secure local and national Native American speakers, conduct workshops in the school systems, expand and sponsor public cultural events, assist with the annual fund-raiser for the Mark Ulmer Scholarship Fund, support Native American student organizations, and attend conferences and workshops.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
