- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Triangle Native 5 American Society, Inc., the sum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) for the 1995-96 6 fiscal year to assist in its mission to educate the general public and promote and protect 7 the traditions and culture of Native Americans. These funds will be used to secure art 8 and traveling exhibits, secure local and national Native American speakers, conduct 9 workshops in the school systems, expand and sponsor public cultural events, assist with 10 the annual fund-raiser for the Mark Ulmer Scholarship Fund, support Native American 11 student organizations, and attend conferences and workshops. 12
