RENOVATION OF THE FORMER FUQUAY-VARINA ELEMENTARY

SCHOOL'S GYMNASIUM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Town of Fuquay-Varina the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 1995-96 fiscal year for the construction of a community center to provide the citizens of Fuquay-Varina a facility for cultural, social, civic, and other community activities.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Fuquay-Varina Community Development Corporation the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for the 1995-96 fiscal year for the renovation of the gymnasium of the former Fuquay-Varina Elementary School to be used by the citizens of Wake County, Fuquay-Varina, and surrounding areas for a variety of activities including recreation, performing arts, after school programs, summer youth programs, and drug prevention counseling.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
