Referred to: Appropriations. May 4, 1995 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO IMPLEMENT A NEW SALARY SCHEDULE FOR CERTIFIED SCHOOL SUPERVISORS, DIRECTORS, AND COORDINATORS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. (a) To the extent that the State Board of Education phases in this salary schedule within funds appropriated by the General Assembly for that purpose, the following salary schedule applies to certified public school supervisors, directors, and coordinators, for the 1995-96 fiscal year: Monthly Salary Step 0-10 2,914 2,972 11 12 3,031 3,092 13 14 3,154

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- (b) Each supervisor, director, or coordinator shall be placed on the step on the salary schedule that reflects one step for every year on their North Carolina professional educator license, and an additional step for every three years of experience as a principal, central office administrator, or equivalent administrator, as defined by the Department of Public Instruction. Placement shall be determined by the local board of education.
- (c) Longevity pay for supervisors, directors, and coordinators shall be as provided for State employees.
- (d) Supervisors, directors, and coordinators, with certification based on academic preparation at the six-year degree level, shall receive a salary supplement of one hundred twenty-six dollars (\$126.00) per month; supervisors, directors, and coordinators, with certification based on academic preparation and at the doctoral degree level, shall be paid a salary supplement of two hundred fifty-three dollars (\$253.00) per month.
- (e) The salary of a certified supervisor, director, or coordinator shall not be less for the 1995-96 fiscal year than it was for the 1994-95 fiscal year solely as a result of placement on the salary schedule established in this section.
- Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to State Aid to Local School Administrative Units the sum of one million five hundred six thousand four hundred fifty-two dollars (\$1,506,452) for the 1995-96 fiscal year and the sum of one million five hundred six thousand four hundred fifty-two dollars (\$1,506,452) for the 1996-97 fiscal year to implement the salary schedule set out in Section 1 of this act.
  - Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
