1 A JOINT RESOLUTION REPEALING A JOINT RESOLUTION CALLING FOR A
2 FEDERAL CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION TO PROPOSE A BALANCED
3 BUDGET AMENDMENT.

4 Whereas, Resolution 5, Session Laws of 1979, called on Congress to call a
5 Constitutional Convention for the purpose of considering an amendment to the
6 Constitution of the United States requiring a balanced federal budget; and

7 Whereas, there is concern that such a convention could not be restricted to the
8 purpose for which it is called, and such a convention could propose radical changes to
9 other parts of our Constitution;

10 Now, therefore, be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring:

11 Section 1. Resolution 5, Session Laws of 1979, is repealed.

12 Sec. 2. The Secretary of State shall send a copy of this resolution and
13 Resolution 5, Session Laws of 1979, to the Clerk of the United States House of
14 Representatives, the Secretary of the United States Senate, and the North Carolina
15 Congressional Delegation.

16 Sec. 3. This resolution is effective upon ratification.
