A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA FOR REPAIR AND RENOVATIONS AT NORTH CAROLINA CENTRAL UNIVERSITY, NORTH CAROLINA AGRICULTURAL AND TECHNICAL STATE UNIVERSITY, AND FAYETTEVILLE STATE UNIVERSITY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) for the 1996-97 fiscal year to be allocated as follows:

- (1) \$500,000 to North Carolina Central University for repairs and renovation of the Shepard House, formerly the chancellor's home, to be used for alumni activities and alumni office space;
- (2) \$500,000 to North Carolina Agricultural & Technical State University for repairs and renovation of "The Oaks", the chancellor's home; and
- (3) \$500,000 to Fayetteville State University for repairs and renovation of the Health and Physical Education Complex.

The funds appropriated in this act shall be in addition to any allocations made to these universities for repairs and renovations.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1996.
