A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE MAXIMUM PERIOD OF TIME A JUVENILE MAY BE
2 COMMITTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH STRUCTURED SENTENCING.

3 Section 1. G.S. 7A-652(c) reads as rewritten:

4 "(c) In no event shall commitment of a delinquent juvenile be for a period of time
5 in excess of ~~that period for which an adult could be committed for the same act. the~~
6 maximum term of imprisonment for which an adult in prior record level VI for felonies
7 or in prior conviction level III for misdemeanors could be sentenced for the same offense.
8 ~~Any juveniles committed for an offense for which an adult would be sentenced for 30~~
9 ~~days or less—~~A juvenile committed only for an offense that would be a Class 3
10 misdemeanor if committed by an adult shall be assigned to a local detention home as
11 defined by G.S. 7A-517(15) or a regional home as defined by G.S. 7A-517(26)."

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1995, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
