6	"(14) 'Facil	ity' means any person at one location whose primary purpose is to
7	provid	de services for the care, treatment, habilitation, or rehabilitation of
8	the m	entally ill, the developmentally disabled, or substance abusers, and

10	a.	An 'area facility', which is a facility that is operated by or under
11		contract with the area authority. A facility that is providing
12		services under contract with the area authority is an area facility
13		for purposes of the contracted services only. Area facilities may
14		also be licensable facilities in accordance with Article 2 of this
15		Chapter. A State facility is not an area facility;
16	b.	A 'licensable facility', which is a facility that provides services
17		for one or more minors or for two-five or more adults. When the
18		services offered are provided to individuals who are mentally ill
19		or developmentally disabled, these services shall be day services
20		offered to the same individual for a period of three hours or more

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1 2 3		during a 24-hour period, or residential services provided for 24 consecutive hours or more. When the services offered are provided to individuals who are substance abusers, these services
4		shall include all outpatient services, day services offered to the
5		same individual for a period of three hours or more during a 24-
6 7		hour period, or residential services provided for 24 consecutive hours or more. Facilities for individuals who are substance
8 9		abusers include chemical dependency facilities;
