A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR FOR 3 EXPANSION OF THE APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM.
 - Whereas, the 21st century will require fully qualified, skilled, and knowledgeable workers; and

Whereas, the Department of Labor has over 55 years experience in establishing and administering federally recognized and approved on-the-job and in-class training programs for workers in a wide variety of technical skill areas; and

Whereas, this training must be sanctioned according to the standards set for individual skill areas and approved by the federal government; and

Whereas, it is increasingly important that the providers of skills training recognize the necessity of preparing workers to have transferable talents and accreditation which will be available to them in their job seeking throughout the United States of America; and

Whereas, training programs must begin with the employers' needs and must be directed toward standards set for individual skill areas and recognized across employer and state lines; and

Whereas, the public must know exactly what they are getting for funds appropriated; and Whereas, the Department of Labor will have 12,000 registered apprentices by the year 2000 if these funds are appropriated; Now, therefore,

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of 2 Labor the sum of eight hundred ninety-seven thousand four hundred three dollars 3 (\$897,403) for the 1995-96 fiscal year and the sum of eight hundred thirty thousand one 4 hundred eighteen dollars (\$830,118) for the 1996-97 fiscal year to expand the 5 apprenticeship program and provide training for registered apprentices.

6 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
