A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE TEACCH PROGRAM, WHICH
PROVIDES EDUCATION AND TREATMENT TO CHILDREN AND ADULTS
WITH AUTISM AND OTHER COMMUNICATION HANDICAPS.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of four hundred thirty-three thousand eighty-five dollars (\$433,085) for the 1995-96 fiscal year and the sum of four hundred thirty-three thousand eighty-five dollars (\$433,085) for the 1996-97 fiscal year, for the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, Health Affairs, for TEACCH, the Treatment and Education of Autistic and other Communication-Handicapped Children and Adults Program, to enable the TEACCH outreach program to serve more autistic children.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
