A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1
2 AN ACT TO ABOLISH THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION AND
3 TRANSFER ITS FUNCTIONS TO THE OFFICE OF STATE BUDGET AND
4 MANAGEMENT IN THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, AND TO DIRECT THE
5 OFFICE OF STATE BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT TO ELIMINATE FIFTY
6 PERCENT OF POSITIONS IN THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF
7 ADMINISTRATION.

8 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

9 Section 1. The statutory authority, powers, duties and functions, records,
10 personnel, property, unexpended balances of appropriations, allocations or other funds,
11 including the functions of budgeting and purchasing, of the Department of
12 Administration are transferred to the Office of State Budget and Management of the
13 Office of the Governor. The Department of Administration is abolished.

14 Sec. 2. (a) The Revisor of Statutes shall change any cross-references in the General
15 Statutes to the "Department of Administration" to the "Office of State Budget and
16 Management", and shall change any references to the "Secretary of Administration" or
17 the "Secretary of the Department of Administration" to the "State Budget Officer".

18 (b) Any references in any laws other than those referred to in subsection (a) of this
19 section which refer to the "Department of Administration" shall be construed to be
20 references to the "Office of State Budget and Management", and any references to the

1 "Secretary of Administration" or the "Secretary of the Department of Administration"
 2 shall be construed to be to the "State Budget Officer".

3 Sec. 3. The State Budget Officer shall develop a plan for the elimination of
 4 fifty percent (50%) of the positions within the office of the Secretary of Administration
 5 and shall implement that plan upon transfer of the Department of Administration to the
 6 Office of State Budget and Management pursuant to Section 1 of this act.

7 Sec. 4. G.S. 143B-6(8) is repealed.

8 Sec. 5. G.S. 143B-10 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

9 "(a1) Notwithstanding that the Office of State Budget and Management is in the
 10 Office of the Governor under Chapter 143A of the General Statutes, the Office of State
 11 Budget and Management shall be considered a principal State Department for the purpose
 12 of this Part. The State Budget Officer shall be considered the head of the department for
 13 the purpose of this Part."

14 Sec. 6. G.S. 20-79.5(a) reads as rewritten:

15 "(a) Plates. – The State government officials listed in this section are
 16 eligible for a special registration plate under G.S. 20-79.4. The plate shall bear the
 17 number designated in the following table for the position held by the official.

23 **"§ 147-45. Distribution of copies of State publications.**

24 The Secretary of State shall, at the State's expense, as soon as possible after
 25 publication, provide such number of copies of the Session Laws and Senate and House
 26 Journals to federal, State, and local governmental officials, departments and agencies,
 27 and to educational institutions of instruction and exchange use, as is set out in the table
 28 below:

2 request from their respective department head to the Secretary of State, and upon the
3 discretion of the Secretary of State as to need, be issued copies of the Session Laws on a
4 permanent loan basis with the understanding that should said copies be needed they will
5 be recalled."

6 Sec. 8. Section 3 of this act is effective upon ratification. The remainder of
7 this act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
