April 12, 1995 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT IT IS A CLASS 1 MISDEMEANOR TO SELL AN ITEM IN A VENDING MACHINE THAT IT IS ILLEGAL FOR A MINOR TO PURCHASE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. Article 39 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 14-321.1. Vending machines shall not sell items minors are prohibited from purchasing. Definitions. – The following definitions apply in this section: (a) Coin- or currency-operated machine. Any coin- or currency- operated (1) vending machine or other coin- or currency-activated machine or device. Minor. A person who is less than 18 years old. (2) Offense. - It is unlawful to sell an item in a coin- or currency-operated (b) machine that it is illegal for a minor to purchase. A violation of this section is a Class 1 misdemeanor." Sec. 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 1995, and applies to offenses
