A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE NORTH CAROLINA BOARD OF LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTS TO CHARGE REASONABLE FEES FOR THE REGISTRATION EXAMINATION TO RECOVER ALL COSTS FOR THE EXAMINATION MATERIALS AND TO DELETE REFERENCES TO TEMPORARY PERMITS ISSUED BY THE BOARD.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 89A-6 reads as rewritten:

"§ 89A-6. Fees.

Fees are to be determined by the ~~Board, but~~ Board. Fees for the items listed in the table below shall not exceed the amounts specified herein, however, fees must in the table. The fee for an examination shall be the purchase price of the examination plus an additional fee not to exceed twenty-five dollars (\$25.00). All fees set by the Board shall reflect actual expenses of the Board.

License by reciprocity	250.00
Annual license renewal	100.00

5 Fees shall be paid to the Board at the times specified by the Board."

6 Sec. 2. G.S. 89A-2(a) reads as rewritten:

7 "(a) ~~On and after January 1, 1970, no~~ No person shall use the designation 'landscape
 8 architect,' 'landscape architecture,' or 'landscape architectural,' or advertise any title or
 9 description tending to convey the impression that ~~he~~ the person is a landscape architect
 10 unless ~~such~~ the person is registered ~~or has obtained a temporary permit with the Board~~ as a
 11 landscape architect in the manner hereinafter provided and shall thereafter ~~architect.~~ A
 12 landscape architect shall comply with the provisions of this Chapter. Every ~~holder of~~
 13 person who holds a certificate shall display it in a conspicuous place in ~~his~~ the person's
 14 principal ~~office,~~ place of business or employment."

15 Sec. 3. G.S. 89A-4(c) reads as rewritten:

16 "(c) The Board, within its discretion, may issue ~~temporary permits pending~~
 17 ~~examinations, or without examination may grant~~ licenses, by ~~reciprocity,~~ reciprocity and
 18 without examination, to persons holding a license or certificate in landscape architecture
 19 from any legally constituted board of examiners in another state whose registration
 20 requirements are deemed to be equal or equivalent to those of this State."

21 Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
