Sec. 2. G.S. 89A-2(a) reads as rewritten:

- "(a) On and after January 1, 1970, no-No person shall use the designation 'landscape architect,' 'landscape architecture,' or 'landscape architectural,' or advertise any title or description tending to convey the impression that he the person is a landscape architect unless such the person is registered or has obtained a temporary permit with the Board as a landscape architect in the manner hereinafter provided and shall thereafter architect. A landscape architect shall comply with the provisions of this Chapter. Every holder of person who holds a certificate shall display it in a conspicuous place in his the person's principal office, place of business or employment."
 - Sec. 3. G.S. 89A-4(c) reads as rewritten:
- "(c) The Board, within its discretion, may issue temporary permits pending examinations, or without examination may grant licenses, by reciprocity, reciprocity and without examination, to persons holding a license or certificate in landscape architecture from any legally constituted board of examiners in another state whose registration requirements are deemed to be equal or equivalent to those of this State."
 - Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
