A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT A FORMER GOVERNOR OF THE STATE WHO HAS  
2 SERVED AS A MEMBER OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA  
3 BOARD OF GOVERNORS SHALL BE A MEMBER EMERITUS OF THE  
4 BOARD OF GOVERNORS AND TO PROHIBIT THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS  
5 FROM ELECTING A CHAIRMAN BETWEEN THE TIME THAT THE GENERAL  
6 ASSEMBLY ELECTS MEMBERS AND THOSE MEMBERS TAKE OFFICE.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 Section 1. G.S. 116-6(g) reads as rewritten:

9 "(g) Effective July 1, 1991, and thereafter, any person who has served ~~at least one~~  
10 ~~term~~ as a member of the Board of Governors after having served as Governor of North  
11 Carolina shall be a member emeritus of the Board of Governors, with all the rights and  
12 privileges of membership as in G.S. 116-6(f)."

13 Sec. 2. G.S. 116-8 reads as rewritten:

14 **"§ 116-8. Chairman, vice-chairman and secretary.**

15 The Board of Governors shall elect from its membership for two-year terms, and  
16 until their successors have been elected and qualified, a chairman, a vice-chairman and a  
17 secretary. Notwithstanding the previous sentence, if a vacancy occurs in the office of  
18 chairman between the time that the second house elects members of the Board of  
19

1 Governors under G.S. 116-6 and the time they are to take office under G.S. 116-5, the  
2 Board of Governors may not elect a chairman during that period, the vice-chairman shall  
3 act as chairman, and if there is neither a chairman nor a vice-chairman, the Board of  
4 Governors may elect one of its members chairman pro tempore. No person may serve as  
5 chairman more than four years in succession."

6           Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
