**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE  
FOR THE PURCHASE OF THE TOWN CREEK PROPERTY SITE FOR THE  
EXPANSION OF THE NORTH CAROLINA MARITIME MUSEUM.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Agriculture the sum of three million two hundred thousand dollars (\$3,200,000) for the 1996-97 fiscal year for the purchase of the Town Creek Property Site which will be used to expand the North Carolina Maritime Museum. Purchasing the property will enable the North Carolina Maritime Museum to meet its growth needs, promote increased tourism, and provide additional educational programs on North Carolina coastal history, natural history, and maritime history.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1996.
