There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Rural Economic 6 7 Development Center, Inc., the sum of one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000) for the 1995-96 fiscal year to be allocated as follows: 8 \$25,000 to the Opportunities Industrialization Center of Wilson, 9 (1) Incorporated, for its ongoing job training programs; and 10 \$25,000 to the Opportunities Industrialization Center, Incorporated, in 11 (2) Rocky Mount, for its ongoing job training programs; and 12 \$25,000 to the Opportunities Industrialization Center of Pitt-Greenville, 13 (3) N.C., Inc., for its ongoing job training programs; and 14 15 \$25,000 to the Kinston-Lenoir Opportunities Industrialization Center. (4) Incorporated, for its ongoing job training programs; and 16 \$25,000 to the Halifax-Northampton Opportunities Industrialization 17 (5) Center, Incorporated, for its ongoing job training programs. 18
