5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. Article 21 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes is amended by
7	adding a new section to read:
8	" <u>§ 143-215A. Citizen Water Quality Monitoring Program.</u>
9	The Department shall establish a Citizen Water Quality Monitoring Program to
10	provide an avenue for individuals to play a role in and to take personal responsibility for
11	protecting the State's water quality. The goals of the Citizen Water Quality Monitoring
12	Program are to coordinate monitoring activities among volunteers by river basins; to
13	provide adequate training of volunteers and quality assurance of all data collected; to
14	establish a comprehensive data collection system that supplements the State's data; to
15	incorporate the data collected by volunteers into the State's overall management of water
16	quality; and to provide access of the data to the public through a centralized database
17	located in the Center for Marine Science and Technology."
18	Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
19	Environment, Health, and Natural Resources, Division of Environmental Management,

20 the sum of five hundred eighty-eight thousand dollars (\$588,000) in recurring funds for

- the 1996-97 fiscal year for four positions and operating expenses to establish a 1 2
  - coordinated Citizen Monitoring Program within the Department.
- Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1996. 3
