1 AN ACT RECOMMENDED BY THE BLUE RIBBON TASK FORCE ON THE ISSUE
2 OF THE POTENTIAL IMPACT OF FEDERAL BLOCK GRANT FUNDING AND
3 OTHER FEDERAL ACTIONS ON MEDICAID IN NORTH CAROLINA TO
4 EXTEND THE STUDY.
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6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. Section 23.5A(d) of Chapter 507 of the 1995 Session Laws reads as
8 rewritten:

9 "(d) The task force shall report the results of its study, together with any legislative
10 proposals and cost analyses, to the 1995 General Assembly, Regular Session 1996, within
11 a week of its ~~convening or convening~~, to a special session of the 1995 General Assembly
12 called to deal with federal block grant funding ~~issues~~ issues, or to the 1997 General
13 Assembly within a week of its convening."

14 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
