May 27, 1996 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT RECOMMENDED BY THE BLUE RIBBON TASK FORCE ON THE ISSUE OF THE POTENTIAL IMPACT OF FEDERAL BLOCK GRANT FUNDING AND OTHER FEDERAL ACTIONS ON MEDICAID IN NORTH CAROLINA TO EXTEND THE STUDY. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. Section 23.5A(d) of Chapter 507 of the 1995 Session Laws reads as rewritten: The task force shall report the results of its study, together with any legislative proposals and cost analyses, to the 1995 General Assembly, Regular Session 1996, within a week of its convening or convening, to a special session of the 1995 General Assembly called to deal with federal block grant funding issues. issues, or to the 1997 General Assembly within a week of its convening." Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
