1                                   A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO SPECIFY THAT ONE MEMBER OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL  
3 MANAGEMENT COMMISSION SHALL HAVE EMPLOYMENT EXPERIENCE  
4 IN INDUSTRIAL AIR AND WATER POLLUTION CONTROL AT AN  
5 INDUSTRIAL MANUFACTURING FACILITY, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE  
6 ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW COMMISSION.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8           Section 1. G.S. 143B-283(a) reads as rewritten:

9       "(a) The Environmental Management Commission shall consist of 13 members  
10 appointed by the Governor. The Governor shall select the members so that the  
11 membership of the Commission shall consist of:

- 12           (1) One who shall be a licensed physician with specialized training and  
13           experience in the health effects of environmental pollution;  
14           (2) One who shall, at the time of appointment, be actively connected with  
15           the Commission for Health Services or local board of health or have  
16           experience in health sciences;  
17           (3) One who shall, at the time of appointment, be actively connected with  
18           or have had experience in agriculture;

- 1 (4) One who shall, at the time of appointment, be a registered engineer with  
2 specialized training and experience in water supply or water or air  
3 pollution control;
- 4 (5) One who shall, at the time of appointment, be actively connected with  
5 or have had experience in the fish and wildlife conservation activities of  
6 the State;
- 7 (6) One who shall, at the time of appointment, have special training and  
8 scientific expertise in hydrogeology or groundwater hydrology;
- 9 (7) Three members interested in water and air pollution control, appointed  
10 from the public at large;
- 11 (8) One who shall, at the time of appointment, be actively ~~connected with~~  
12 employed by, or recently retired from, an industrial production or have  
13 ~~had experience manufacturing facility~~ in the field of industrial air and  
14 water pollution control;
- 15 (9) One who shall, at the time of appointment, be actively connected with  
16 or have had experience in pollution control problems of municipal or  
17 county government;
- 18 (10) One who shall, at the time of appointment, have special training and  
19 scientific expertise in air pollution control and the effects of air  
20 pollution; and
- 21 (11) One who shall, at the time of appointment, have special training and  
22 scientific expertise in freshwater, estuarine, marine biological, or  
23 ecological sciences."

24 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification and applies to any appointment to  
25 the Environmental Management Commission pursuant to G.S. 143B-283(a)(8), as  
26 amended by Section 1 of this act, made on or after the date this act becomes effective.
