A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO MAKE A TECHNICAL CORRECTION TO G.S. 120-70.2 REGARDING
2 FILLING OF VACANCIES ON THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE UTILITY REVIEW
3 COMMITTEE AS RECOMMENDED BY THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE UTILITY
4 REVIEW COMMITTEE.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. G.S. 120-70.2 reads as rewritten:

8 "**§ 120-70.2. Appointment of members and organization.**

9 The Joint Committee shall consist of six sitting members of the General Assembly.
10 Three shall be appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate from the
11 membership of the Senate and three shall be appointed by the Speaker of the House of
12 Representatives from the membership of the House. Members will serve at the pleasure
13 of their appointing officer and any vacancies occurring on the Joint Committee shall be
14 filled by the ~~presiding~~appointing officer of the appropriate house. The President Pro
15 Tempore of the Senate shall designate one Senator to serve as cochairman and the
16 Speaker of the House of Representatives shall designate one Representative to serve as
17 cochairman. A quorum shall consist of four members."

18 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
