A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE SCHOOL TECHNOLOGY FUND.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the State School Technology Fund, the sum of seventy-one million dollars (\$71,000,000) for the 1995-96 fiscal year and the sum of seventy-two million dollars (\$72,000,000) for the 1996-97 fiscal year to implement the local school technology plans. The State Board of Education shall allocate these funds on an average daily membership basis.

These funds are nonrecurring funds.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
