A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A SEASON FOR HUNTING FOXES WITH FIREARMS
AND BOW AND ARROW IN CALDWELL COUNTY.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, there is an open season for hunting, taking, or killing foxes with firearms and bow and arrow during the season for hunting any game animal as established by the North Carolina Wildlife Resources Commission.

Sec. 2. Section 4 of Chapter 636 of the 1977 Session Laws, as rewritten by Section 3 of Chapter 163 of the 1989 Session Laws and by Section 5 of Chapter 616 of the 1989 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

"Sec. 4. This act shall apply only to ~~Caldwell~~, Harnett, Lee, and Martin Counties."

Sec. 3. This act applies only to Caldwell County.

Sec. 4. This act becomes effective October 1, 1995.
