SENATE BILL 267

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE ALZHEIMER'S ASSOCIATIONS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of Aging, Department of Human Resources, the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 1995-96 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 1996-97 fiscal year to be divided equally among the four chapters of the Alzheimer's Association of North Carolina as follows: the Western Alzheimer's Chapter, the Southern Piedmont Alzheimer's Chapter, the Eastern Alzheimer's Chapter, and the Triad Alzheimer's Chapter.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
