Referred to: Commerce March 8, 1995 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO RAISE THE MAXIMUM LATE PAYMENT CHARGE FOR REVOLVING CREDIT LOANS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 24-11(d1) reads as rewritten:

"(d1) A lender may charge a party to a loan or extension of credit governed by this section a late payment charge not to exceed five dollars (\$5.00) twelve dollars (\$12.00) for any payment past due for 30 days or more. If a late payment charge has been once imposed with respect to a late payment, no late charge shall be imposed with respect to

any future payment which would have been timely and sufficient but for the previous default."
