SENATE BILL 433

Short Title: Charlotte Repair/Construction Limit.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE TO SUBMIT PROPOSALS
AND RECEIVE CONTRACTS FOR CONSTRUCTION AND REPAIR WORK
NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 143-129 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

"(g) The City of Charlotte may submit a proposal for any construction or repair work governed by this section when the total cost of the work is estimated not to exceed two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000), and in these situations, the provisions of G.S. 143-135 shall not apply. The proposal shall be opened in public and recorded in the minute books and may be awarded to the City without an accompanying bond. When a proposal is awarded to the City, the City shall not be required to execute a written contract with itself."

Sec. 2. This act applies only to the City of Charlotte.

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
