AN ACT TO ALLOW THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO ISSUE
RESTRICTED COMMERCIAL DRIVERS LICENSES TO SEASONAL DRIVERS
FOR CERTAIN FARM-RELATED SERVICES INDUSTRIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
Section 1. Article 2C of Chapter 20 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 20-37.14A. Seasonal, restricted commercial drivers license.

- (a) <u>License Scope. A seasonal, restricted commercial drivers license authorizes</u> the holder of the license to drive, on behalf of the holder's employer, certain Class B and <u>Class C commercial motor vehicles during the season indicated on the license within 150 miles of the place of business of the holder's employer. The Class B and Class C commercial motor vehicles to which the license applies are:</u>
  - (1) Those that are not transporting hazardous materials.
  - Those that are transporting any of the following hazardous materials and are therefore required to be placarded in accordance with 49 C.F.R. Part 172, Subpart F:
    - a. Diesel fuel in quantities of 1,000 gallons or less.
