2	AN ACT TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT THAT MAY BE RECOVERED
3	IN STRICT LIABILITY FOR DAMAGE TO PERSON OR PROPERTY BY
4	MINORS.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. G.S. 1-538.1 reads as rewritten:
7	"§ 1-538.1. Strict liability for damage to person or property by minors.
8	Any person or other legal entity shall be entitled to recover actual damages suffered in
9	an amount not to exceed a total of two thousand dollars (\$2,000) five thousand dollars
10	(\$5,000) from the parent or parents of any <u>unemancipated</u> minor who shall maliciously or
11	willfully injure such person or destroy the real or personal property of such person.
12	Parents whose custody and control have been removed by court order or by contract prior
13	to the act complained of shall not be liable under this act. This act shall not preclude or
14	limit recovery of damages from parents under common law remedies available in this
15	State."
16	Sec. 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1995, and applies to causes of
17	actions arising on or after that date.
