**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE D.A.R.E. PROGRAM TO EXPAND IT TO EVERY FIFTH, SEVENTH, AND NINTH GRADE CLASS IN THE STATE, AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE STATEWIDE HOOKUP OF COMPUTER COMPATIBLE INTOXILIZERS WITH THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE COURTS' COMPUTER SYSTEM.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Instruction the sum of eight hundred ninety-eight thousand four hundred five dollars (\$898,405) for the 1995-96 fiscal year to provide textbooks and supplies for the D.A.R.E. Program in all fifth, seventh, and ninth grades in the State. Approximately one hundred eighty-seven thousand dollars (\$187,000) shall be used for the elementary school program. Approximately two hundred forty thousand eight hundred seventeen dollars (\$240,817) shall be used for the middle school program. Approximately four hundred seventy thousand five hundred eighty-eight dollars (\$470,588) shall be used for the high school program.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Administrative Office of the Courts the sum of six hundred fifty-four thousand dollars (\$654,000) for the 1995-96 fiscal year for the statewide hookup of computer compatible intoxicilizers with the Administrative Office of the Courts' computer system.

1           Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
