A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE TO CONDUCT A FEASIBILITY STUDY ON THE CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF AN 3 4 EASTERN CONVENTION CENTER. 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. The Department of Commerce shall conduct a feasibility study on 6 7 the construction and operation of a convention center to serve the eastern region of North 8 Carolina. The study shall include recommendations on the following: 9 The necessity for a convention center to serve the eastern region of the (1) 10 State: Whether a convention center would significantly contribute to economic 11 (2) development in the region it serves; 12 The counties in the eastern region that would be best served by a 13 (3) convention center: 14 The county or municipality in which the convention center should be 15 (4) constructed and the reasons therefor; 16 The estimated cost to construct and to operate the center annually; and 17 (5) The likelihood of obtaining non-State funding for construction and 18 (6)

operation and the possible sources of such funding.

Sec. 2. The Department of Commerce shall report the progress of the
feasibility study to the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations at its
December 1995 meeting, and shall make its final report to the General Assembly on or
before May 1, 1996.

- Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Commerce the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 1995-96 fiscal year to conduct the study authorized under Section 1 of this act.
 - Sec. 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
